

YOUR NEXT STEPS JOURNEY

YEAR 12

OCTOBER:

Widening participation scheme information assembly.

JANUARY - APRIL:

Next steps interviews with a progression tutor on current working grades and suitability to next steps vision.

MARCH:

Destinations Manager meets with potential early applicants. Director of Student Progress meets with any student with a G Score of 6+ to encourage them to apply to at least one Russell Group university.

MARCH - JUNE:

CORE lessons focus on different pathways and careers; student finance and how any student can afford university; skills for life; looking at potential courses; and entry requirements versus current working grades.

JUNE:

Start outline of personal statements and get feedback from staff. Start and complete UCAS application form.

YEAR 13

SEPTEMBER:

Key upcoming UCAS dates, alternatives to university, personal statement completion.

OCTOBER:

Early applicant deadline.

DECEMBER:

Internal UCAS deadline.

JANUARY:

External UCAS deadline.

MARCH:

Information on results day, UCAS extra, clearing and student finance, support with apprenticeship applications.
